California Hunter Education

Summary:

California requires hunter education training for those who have never held a California hunting license, who do not have a hunter education certificate, or who do not have a hunting license from another state or province issued within the past two years. Students may choose between two class format options: 1) Traditional Course and 2) Online Course with Follow-up Class. Classes are offered throughout the State by more than 1,000 certified volunteer instructors, all dedicated to keeping hunting safe, ethical, and available to all Californians.

Traditional Hunter Education Course – Option 1

Description:

This course consists of instruction in the following areas: firearms safety and handling, sportsmanship and ethics, wildlife management and conservation, archery, black powder, wildlife identification, game care, first air, and survival. After a student successfully completes the course and passes the final examination, they are awarded a Certificate of Completion. The Traditional Course allows for individual interaction with the instructor. The Traditional Course is most often preferred by first time hunters.

Online Course and Follow-up Class - Option 2

Description:

The online course, alone, is NOT a qualification for a hunter education certificate. Once you have completed an online course, you will still need to attend a 4-hour follow up class with a certified Hunter Education Instructor. Access is permitted to the 4-hour follow-up class only after a student has completed the written Home Study or Online component of the class.
