

Prop 54– VOTE YES!

This proposition would require the legislature to print and publish any bill for at least 72 hours prior to being voted on. No more gut and amend process that law-makers are known for!

Prop 57– VOTE NO!

Would increase parole and good behavior opportunities for felons. Would allow judges to decide whether to try certain juveniles as adults. Basically, felons could get early release.

Prop 59– VOTE NO!

A yes vote supports over-turning the *Citizens United v. Federal Election Commission* through the federal legislative process. No actual impact on California law. A yes vote could have serious impacts on NRA and CRPA political activities and support.

Prop 62– VOTE NO!

Would repeal California's death penalty. This is opposed by law enforcement.

Prop 63– VOTE NO!

Would have major infringements on our ability to protect ourselves and our families. It will not keep you safer from criminals and it is opposed by all major law enforcement groups! CRPA has fought long and hard to stop this prop!

Prop 66– VOTE YES!

Changes procedures for challenging death penalty convictions and speeds up the process. Supported by all major law enforcement groups.
