President Ronald Reagan in his farewell address to the American people from the Oval Office made two observations that are often quoted and directly apply to where we as proud pro Second Amendment Californians find ourselves today.

Litigation – With the advent of a new Supreme Court of The United States (SCOTUS) with the election of Donald Trump as President, CRPA, working with the NRA, will move forward numerous litigation cases to secure your rights, repeal bad laws and stop the opposition both here locally and nationwide.

Political – CRPA is currently expanding its Coalition of Local Gun Owners grassroots program into your local area. These groups will be assisting us in expanding programs in their area while helping us in politically insuring pro 2A candidates get

elected. We are here to remove bad candidates and replace them with people who support the Second Amendment.

Hunting – CRPA is working with the California Hunting & Conservation Coalition throughout the state to advance hunting and to educate the community at large in scientific based conservation rather than emotional based ideas of the anti-hunting community. We are holding seminars statewide to educate the public about hunters and to turn hunters into ambassadors for the sport.

Community Outreach – CRPA is reaching out to local communities and working with them to bring safety, education, and a deeper knowledge of the shooting sports. Many of these programs are working in tandem with the National Rifle Association, other 2A groups, hunting organizations and manufacturers to form sustainable programs in these communities.

Training – This year CRPA opened up its new training center and has continually held sold-out classes. We are working with local trainers statewide to help them expand training in their respective areas. The more students we can get trained the more people we add to the ranks.

Events – We are tailoring events to the needs of our members in their areas. These events range from political, training, hunting and much more. These events can be tailored as stand-alone or as an organization-wide event for your local group. The goal here is to give you, our members, a chance to interact and see the benefits of your membership.
