

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION BULLETIN

ATF'S RECENT ACTIONS CONCERNING POLYMER80 "BUY, BUILD, SHOOT" KITS

## **DECEMBER 18, 2020**

Early in the morning on December 10, 2020, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives ("ATF") executed a search warrant on the business premises of the Federal Firearms Licensee ("FFL") Polymer80, Inc., in Dayton, Nevada. Among the items ATF seized were "Buy, Build, Shoot" kits, components of such kits, and any communications and recordings concerning the manufacture, design, marketing, sale, shipment, and transfer of such kits. (Please note that the scope of the warrant was limited solely to the Buy Shoot Kits and did not address other Polymer80 products.) Immediately following the execution of this warrant, many other FFLs, distributors, and even individual purchasers reported being contacted by ATF concerning these same kits.

CRPA's attorneys are working closely with firearm attorneys throughout the country on this issue, and in the coming days will be publishing additional information regarding ATF's actions. CRPA members and gun owners who purchased or currently possess a "Buy, Build, Shoot" kit from Polymer80 should know that ATF has not taken any criminal enforcement actions against such individuals. That said, CRPA would like to take this opportunity to advise its members that should you be contacted by law enforcement (ATF agents or otherwise) for any reason concerning your acquisition and/or current possession of such kits, to exercise their rights and politely decline to speak to them without the presence of an attorney.
