

What is CRPA?

The California Rifle & Pistol Associaton (CRPA) founded in 1875, is a nonprofit 501(c)(4) membership and donor-supported organization. CRPA works relentlessly in California to defend your constitutional right to keep and bear arms. CRPA employs staff in Fullerton and Sacramento, works with hundreds of volunteers across the state, and is controlled by an independent Board of Directors. All dues and donations to CRPA are used specifically to benefit California gun owners through CRPA programs.

The CRPA Foundation

Donations to The CRPA Foundation (CRPAF) are used for the direct benefit of Californians. The CRPAF has its own Board of Trustees. Grants from CRPAF benefit a wide variety of constituencies throughout California, including eligible CRPA Programs that educate and benefit youth, women, gun collectors, hunters, target shooters, law enforcement, disabled shooters, and those who choose to own a gun to defend themselves and their families.

CRPAF's lawyers and experts work to strike down unconstitutional laws in court, defend and expand legal recognition of the rights protected by the Second Amendment, promote firearms and hunting safety, protect hunting rights, enhance marksmanship skills of those participating in shooting sports, and educate the public about firearms and their historic, technological, and aesthetic significance.

The CRPAF is a 501(c)(3) tax exempt entity, so contributions to CRPAF are tax deductible to the extent allowed by the law.

CRPA Political Action Committees

CRPA's political efforts are often coordinated through the CRPA's Political Action Committees, the CRPA-PACs. CRPA's PACs are formed to comply with California's campaign finance laws. CRPA-PACs seek to influence campaigns and elections at the state and local level to get people elected who understand the importance of the constitutional right to keep and bear arms, appreciate that firearms have social utility, and realize that gun control laws and gun bans do not work.
