11. Do you support laws allowing a person injured by a properly working firearm to sue firearms manufacturers or sellers instead of the person actually committing the injury? ("Strict liability" laws hold uninvolved third parties guilty for negligent or criminal acts of others).

12. Do you support laws requiring all semi-auto handguns to stamp microscopic information on all fired cartridges so that law enforcement can trace the guns to the registered owners? (Note that a federal court has already ruled this in violation of the Bruen decision)

(a federal court ruled this unconstitutional under Bruen, and that case is on appeal by the state)

Two of the largest states, Florida and Texas, have tracked the CCW statistics and reported that virtually no crimes are committed by permittees. In California, permit issuance is left solely to the discretion of local law enforcement, a system that often results in political favoritism to political contributors).*
