

CRPA Action and Response Plan to AB 3071

Banning Lead Ammunition at Ranges

CRPA is bringing together clubs, ranges and members to fight back! Thank you for taking the first step and responding to this email to find out the game plan and how your range, club, and members can help.

Proposed Assembly Bill 3071

The legislature has introduced Assembly Bill 3071, which would completely ban the sale and use of lead ammunition at California shooting ranges. The scarcity and expense of non-lead ammunition will make it impossible for many to afford target practice or shooting sports in a safe environment. The impact on youth and Olympic shooting programs will be devastating. The anti-gun crowd knows this and is counting on it. Their one goal is to dissuade people from being gun owners or enjoying gun ownership—no matter what. If you can't train with your firearm, what good are your fundamental rights?

CRPA has a fulltime lobbyist in Sacramento working daily to combat this bill and other numerous bills that are hostile to gun owners. We are able to quickly alert gun owners of any action you can take to assist him in that effort. Writing letters and responding to calls to action are so important in battling something like this because we have to let our voices be heard.

Right now, we are asking you, all of your friends, your club leaders, and range owners who are tired of the government trying to chip away at your rights to stand with us. We hope that this attack is so offensive that you will do all of the things asked of you below, but at least do the ones you can.

Here's how you can help!

- 1) Call the bill sponsor and your assembly member and tell them that you oppose AB 3071. (A phone call ties up their lines and forces them to listen!)
