

CANDIDATE BIOS



BARRY BAUER

Barry began working for his father, Herb Bauer's sporting goods store at age 8. He grew up very involved in the Boy Scout program. He earned a BS in Electrical Engineering, and also joined the Fresno Air National Guard, retiring after 23 years as a Lieutenant Colonel. Barry has an FFL, a Federal Explosives License, a CCW permit, a commercial pilot license, a real estate broker license, a lifetime junior college teaching credential, a ham radio license, and a hunting & fishing license. In his earlier years he was a California State Trap Shooting champion, an off-shore certified sailboat captain, a varsity water polo player, and a scuba diving instructor. He is currently a member of the Fresno County Recreation and Wildlife Commission. Barry has recently retired as President of Herb Bauer Sporting Goods after 20 years. Over the past twenty years, he has been a plaintiff in multiple NRA/CRPA lawsuits, such as *Bauer vs. Becerra*, and has worked on California firearms-related legislation. Barry is a CRPA Lifetime member. He has been Chairman of the Fresno Friends of NRA for 17 years and has recommended approval of over \$100,000 in grants to improve the shooting ranges at the Boy Scout's Camp Chawanakee.



GEORGE EMMERSON

George has served on the Historical Arms Committee, including as Chairperson. He is a CRPA Lifetime member, a member of the Smith & Wesson Collectors, The Ruger Collectors, and the San Gabriel Valley Arms Collectors Association, and has served as President of that group. George has put on displays with members of the San Gabriel Arms Collectors and the Santa Barbara Arms Collectors for the CRPA banquets and the Santa Barbara Gun Show. George is a shooter, re-loader, and collector, which all started with his father at age ten. He enjoys the camaraderie with others and sharing the history of firearms.



PAUL NORDBERG

Paul's father was a shooter and hunter and taught him about firearms safety and how to shoot as a child. In his teens, he and his father would hunt dove and pheasant together. When he became an adult, over 30 years ago, he became an NRA Life member, since then upgrading to be a Benefactor Life Member as well as becoming a Life member of the CRPA. He has worked in the firearms field ranging from being a counterperson at a local gun store in the 1990's to currently owning and running Calguns.net – the largest online community of California firearms owners existing today. Paul has always been a Second Amendment advocate and for the last two decades has been a vocal 2A activist. In addition to serving on the CRPA Board of Directors, he serves as the Vice President of the non-profit Calguns Shooting Sports Association, which focuses on new shooter training, community outreach and Second Amendment education.
